A Social Psychology Experiment: (this is just the start of an experiment not a full experiment)

-Working in groups of four plan out a social psychology experiment. Read pages 732-734 section on "Group pressure and Conformity". May use the internet to search for ideas. Try out your idea- run the experiment and video it. Upload your video and create a simple presentation that shows your trial experiment. Provide explanation of what social conformity is and discuss normative social influence and informational social influence and how if at all they are demonstrated in your experiment. Evaluate your experiment, what worked well, what did not work or could be improved?

Social Psychology Experiment (experiment beginnings)

1. Experiment plan outlined on paper and group members listed with responsibilities of each member listed. (5 marks)
2. Video of Experiment uploaded to a presentation. (20 marks)
3. Provide explanation of what social conformity is and how it relates to your experiment. (5 marks)
4. Discuss normative social influence and informational social influence and how if at all they are demonstrated in your experiment. (15 marks)
5. Evaluate your experiment, what worked well, what did not work or could be improved? (5 marks)
