OUTDOOR EDUCATION SCHEDULE – Grades 10 to 12

Note: This class runs the entire school year September through June.

For full credit all students are required to:

- 1. <u>Attend all scheduled 1.5 hr. long classes</u> (various dates see schedule) lectures/demonstrations designed to give students the basics for success on trips and skill development sessions. Class topics may include: Outdoor clothing and equipment, Outdoor meals/cooking, Emergency planning (10 essentials), Nature awareness, Introduction to Rock Climbing /bouldering. Wilderness First Aid, Navigation map reading, Knots and Tarps, Fire Lighting. **Students will choose between Wednesday after school or Thursday before school class time.**
- 2. <u>Participate in all scheduled skill sessions</u>: Bike repair and maintenance, Kayaking rescue skills, Kayaking Safety and how to pack a kayak. Trip Equipment checks for the trips you plan to attend.
- 3. Participate in 4 Day Trips (or 8 ½ day trips) -Options may Include:

Indoor Climbing

Kayaking Levels 1 and 2

Cycling – Urban Rail Trail and/or Kettle Vally Rail Trail

Wilderness First Aid- certification option
